

Amending renewal application No. 0000120184 8/05/2020 to include this report:

The Board of Directors of Prairie Air, Inc., are aware that the application for renewal for its licensed Station WEFT (FM-Ed), Champaign, IL, was submitted past the deadline for such application. In view of this, the Board decided to engage an experienced telecommunications counsel, Michael Couzens, to audit the Station's files and determine whether there were any compliance issues to disclose in the renewal. Based on his report and other investigation by the Board, we are submitting an amendment to the renewal application, including this statement. It is our purpose to identify all lapses in past compliance, and assure that the Station will be operated going forward in full compliance with the Commission's rules and policies.

The Station submitted an ownership report, Form No. 323E, on 5/22/2019 and another report on 12/10/2019. These reports accurately depict the Station's board composition. The Board as of the December, 2019, report had six long-standing members. From the previous report, two had left through normal turnover and six new members were added. These changes resulted in a change of negative control, with six new and six old members. In light of this, we are submitting a Form No. 316 to report a transfer of control, identifying all the new members.

The audit of station reports showed a period of time in which paper records were kept of quarterly issues and programs, but no reports were uploaded to the on-line public file, from 2Q 2014 through 4Q 2017. Beginning with 1Q 2018 the quarterly reports were compliant. We have attempted in good faith to recover the record of these activities and to upload them to the Station's on-line public file. These records may be incomplete in some particulars for some quarters. However, we do believe that the Station in fact did offer programming responsive to issues of local interest and concern throughout the license period.

Finally, we acknowledge that Station Ownership Reports and EEO reports, while complete and accurate, have been untimely. Going forward it is our intention to make these submissions in a timely manner, as and when required.
