

Online Public Inspection File

During the last license renewal term, Missouri Valley Broadcasting, Inc. (“Licensee”), licensee of KMMO-FM, Marshall, IA (Facility ID No. 43226) (“KMMO-FM”), failed to comply with certain Online Public Inspection File (“OPIF”) requirements with respect to KMMO-FM:

Section 73.3613 Contracts/Documents List. Licensee failed to upload a list of the requisite documents pursuant to Section 73.3613 of the Commission’s rules to KMMO-FM’s OPIF by the requisite deadline. The list was subsequently uploaded to KMMO-FM’s OPIF.

Annual EEO Public File Report. Licensee failed to upload the 2017-2018 Annual EEO Public File Report to KMMO-FM’s OPIF by the requisite deadline. The report was subsequently uploaded to KMMO-FM’s OPIF.

Political File Reports. During the applicable 2-year retention period, Licensee failed to upload immediately to KMMO-FM’s OPIF several of its 2018, 2019, and 2020 Political File Reports. Due to a miscommunication between Licensee and its legal counsel, Licensee initially only uploaded the confirmation orders associated with each political advertising buy. As a result of this miscommunication, Licensee’s counsel mistakenly believed that the contents of the confirmation orders satisfied all of KMMO-FM’s Political File reporting requirements. The confirmation orders included much of the information required, but did not information regarding the political advertisement’s airing date, time, class, and rate. In nearly all cases, those confirmation orders were uploaded within one business day of being prepared. Subsequently, all missing information from each political advertising buy was uploaded to the station’s OPIF. The licensee will ensure in the future that it fully complies with political file reporting requirements.

Issues/Programs List. Licensee failed to upload the Q4 2018 to KMMO-FM’s OPIF by the requisite deadline. The list was subsequently uploaded to KMMO-FM’s OPIF.
