

Simulcast Agreement Disclosure

Nexstar Broadcasting, Inc., licensee of KXAN-TV, Austin, Texas (Fac. ID. 35920), RF Channel 21, proposes to host and simulcast the current ATSC 1.0 – RF Channel 31.4 Antenna TV programming now airing on commonly owned station KBVO-CD, Austin, Texas (Fac. ID. No. 35918) on RF Channel 21.5, and in exchange will be hosted on KBVO-CD in the ATSC 3.0 Format. Pursuant to the FCC’s Public Notice released May 23, 2019, the Media Bureau noted that it will not require commonly owned stations to enter into or maintain written simulcast agreements.¹ Therefore, while Nexstar has answered the simulcasting question “NO” it is in compliance with the simulcasting requirements under 47 CFR § 73.3801 as noted above.
