Minor Change

KGNG-LD lost its lease and was required to move approximately 260 to another tower located on Black Mountain.

This change indicates interference to KPVT-LD. In as much as KPVT-LD had accepted interference from its initial displacement application filed December 2013 to Ch 27, KGNG-LD had a Ch 26 Construction Permit that was granted prior in 2012. At that time, KGNG caused 4.35% interference to KPVT. This minor change to KGNG (moving 260 ft on the same communications site) actually shows a small decrease in interference to KPVT-LD, 4.23%.

As the stations have been co-existing for many years, this minor change is of little consequence.

This is an existing communications site with many towers, no new construction is involved and the site is clearly marked and fenced. The applicant will cooperate and accommodate the needs of any other station at this site as necessary.
