### **Children's Programming Commercial Limitations**

The station that is the subject of this license renewal application, WGNT(DT), was acquired by Scripps Broadcasting Holdings LLC ("Scripps") pursuant to a long-form assignment of license on September 19, 2019. *See* FCC File No. BALCDT-20190410AAL. Scripps is not aware of any violations of the Commission's children's programming commercial limit rules during Scripps' ownership of the station. Scripps notes that because it acquired WGNT(DT) via a long-form assignment application, Scripps is not liable for violations of the prior licensee. However, out of an abundance of caution, Scripps discloses a violation that occurred prior to its acquisition of WGNT(DT).

As disclosed in the station's fourth quarter 2018 commercial limits certification uploaded to the station's online public inspection file, one of the station's programming providers, TBD TV, LLC ("TBD"), inadvertently included a commercial for "Hot Wheels Super Ultimate Garage" on WGNT(DT) during "Team Hot Wheels." TBD included the Hot Wheels Super Ultimate Garage commercial in Team Hot Wheels eleven times between November 10, 2018 and December 16, 2018. TBD pulled the commercial from Team Hot Wheels immediately after discovery and informed its affiliate stations, including WGNT(DT), of TBD's error. WGNT(DT) is unaware of any additional children's programming commercial limit violations caused by TBD. This issue occurred under the previous licensee. Accordingly, Scripps certified "Yes" to the renewal application question regarding "Children's Programming Commercial Limitations" because the violation occurred under the previous licensee prior to the long-form assignment of license, but Scripps is disclosing the violation out of an abundance of caution.
