Periods of Silence

August 15, 2018 - Present

WLMF-LD, Miami, Florida (Facility ID No. 51285) (“WLMF-LD”), went silent on August 15, 2018 due to displacement from its licensed channel by T-Mobile. On August 20, 2018, WLMF-LD’s former licensee, Paging Systems, Inc. (“Paging Systems”), filed a Request for Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to Remain Silent, which was granted by the Commission that same day. *See* LMS File No. 0000059000. On July 2, 2019, Paging Systems filed a request for extension of WLMF-LD’s Silent STA, which was granted by the Commission that same day. *See* LMS File No. 000000075574. On August 5, 2019, Paging Systems filed a second request for extension of WLMF-LD’s Silent STA and a request for waiver of Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, to remain silent for more than 1 year as a result of the repacking process. *See* LMS File No. 0000079915. *See also Expanding the Economic and Innovation Opportunities of Spectrum Through Incentive Auctions*, Report and Order, 29 FCC Rcd 6567 ¶ 585 (2014), *aff’d*, *Nat’l Assoc. of Broadcasters, et al v. FCC*, 789 F.3d 165 (D.C. Cir. 2015). That request still remains pending.

On September 9, 2019, WLMF-LD’s license was assigned from Paging Systems to ATV Holdings, Inc. *See* CDBS File No. BAL-20190717AAL. On September 26, 2019, ATV Holdings filed a minor modification of construction permit application to move WLMF-LD’s displaced facilities to a new tower site, which was granted on October 8, 2019. *See* LMS File No. 0000082244 (expires July 17, 2022). At this time, WLMF-LD remains silent until it can commence operations with its post-transition facilities.
