Dear Licensee:

Your license authorization for the above-referenced station is cancelled, therefore you are required to permanently cease operation of the station.

Commission records indicate that we sent you a letter on July 1, 2020 (July Letter) to inform you that you had failed to file an application to renew your broadcast license authorization.<sup>1</sup> In the July Letter, you were given until 11:59 p.m. (local time) on October 1, 2020, to file a renewal application, which you have not done. We also informed you, if we did not receive your application by the deadline, we would cancel your license authorization and you would be required to permanently cease operation of the station. Our records indicate that you have not filed the renewal application within the time period specified in the July Letter and, as stated above, your license authorization for the above-referenced station is cancelled, therefore you are required to permanently cease operation of the station.
