1. On November 3, 2020, for the second time I went to the tower site identified as ASR 1001786 at the base of the tower.

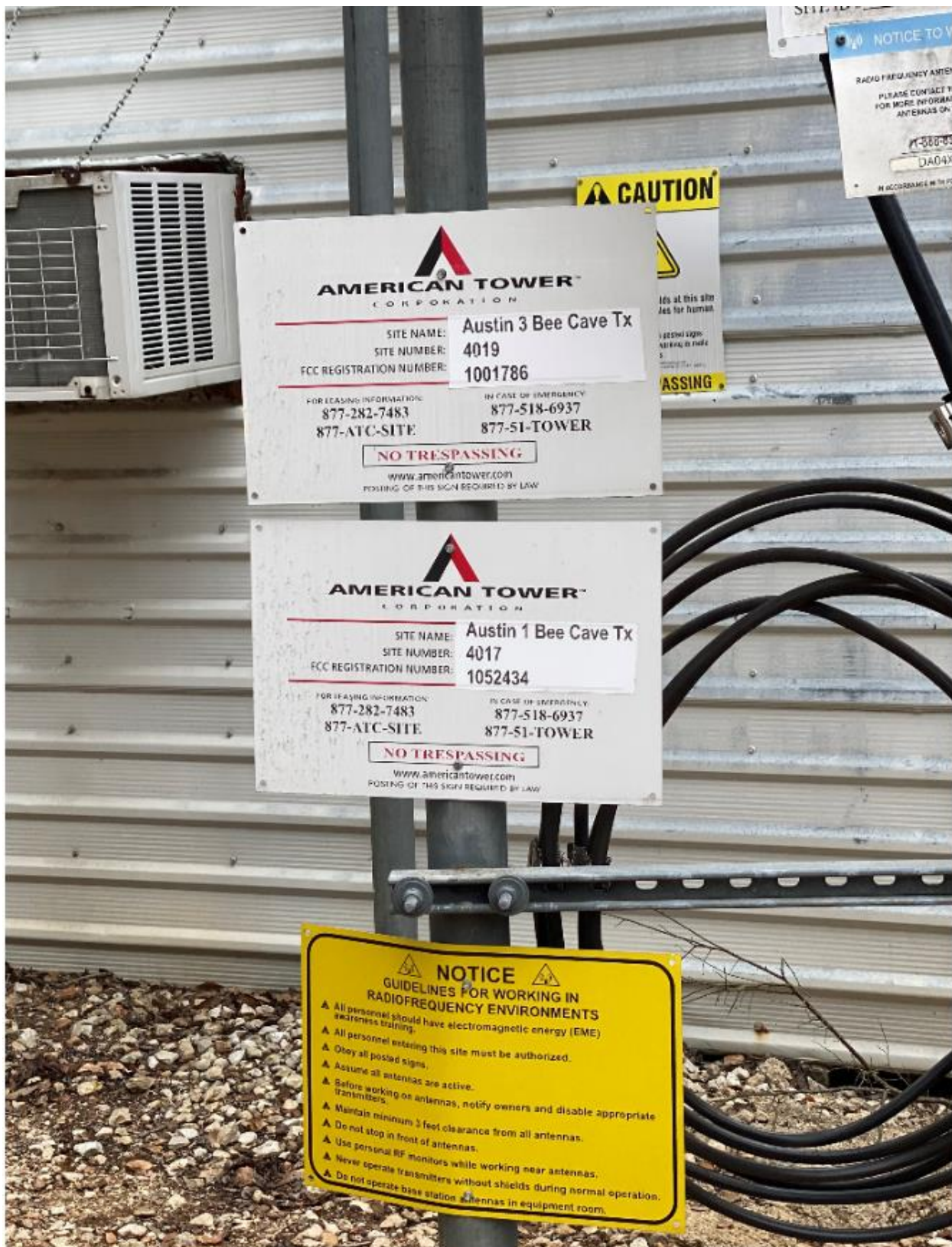

GUIDELINES FOR WORKING IN
RADIOFREQUENCY ENVIRONMENTS

- ▲ All personnel should have electromagnetic energy (EME) awareness training.
- ▲ All personnel entering this site must be authorized.
- ▲ Obey all posted signs.
- ▲ Assume all antennas are active.
- ▲ Before working on antennas, notify owners and disable appropriate transmitters.
- ▲ Maintain minimum 3 feet clearance from all antennas.
- ▲ Do not stop in front of antennas.
- ▲ Use personal RF monitors while working near antennas.
- ▲ Never operate transmitters without shields during normal operation.
- ▲ Do not operate base station antennas in equipment room.
