Special Operating Conditions....

#1 Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file an Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14.

With the submission of the instant Application this condition is met.

#2 BEFORE PROGRAM TESTS COMMENCE, sufficient measurements shall be made to establish that the operation authorized in this construction permit is in compliance with the spurious emissions requirements of 47 C.F.R. Sections 73.317(b) through 73.317(d). All measurements must be made with all stations simultaneously utilizing the shared antenna. These measurements shall be submitted to the Commission along with the FCC application for license.

#3 Warning signs which describe the radiofrequency radiation hazard must be posted at appropriate intervals. Access must be restricted to prevent the exposure of humans to RF emissions in excess of the FCC guidelines (OET Bulletin 65, Edition 97-01, released August 1997). Permittee shall submit documentation of compliance with this special operation condition when filing FCC application for license.

"The K298AW facility is restricted to the public utilizing locked gates, fencing, and signage. Though the site will fully comply with the FCC's controlled and uncontrolled exposure limits, access to the site will be restricted and is appropriately marked with signage. When it becomes necessary for workers to ascend the antenna structure, the permittee will reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines."
