A) Occasion: Current.org Public Media Virtual Career Fair

Date: March 31, 2021

Participating: News Operation Producer (Jan Ross Piedad) and News Director (Dan Katz)

Description: 47 public media organizations across the country participate in a virtual career fair. Texas Public Radio hosted a virtual booth to speak with potential recruits in a group setting, as well as one-on-one.
