FCC Staff,

5NINES LLC (“**5N**”) is providing this “**Buyer Statement**” as it relates to their acquisition of the construction permit for digital low power television station K03IM-D Eugene, OR (FIN 185855) (the “**Permit**”) from Live Sports Radio, LLC (“**LSR**”) (Purchase Agreement signed May 13, 2021 and the Assignment of Authorization filed May 19, 2021) and the Extension of Construction Permit request for this facility that was filed by LSR on March 15, 2021 and the FCC’s letter dated April 29, 2021 requesting more information to support the request.

5N attests and confirms that they have been in discussion with LSR to acquire the Permit and the justification provided in the Extension of Construction Permit filing is true and correct as filed by LSR.

5N is providing the below timeline for their construction and operation of the

station. **Estimated Timeline:**

- May 13, 2021 – LSR and 5N execute an Agreement to acquire the Permit.
- May 19, 2021 – LSR files Assignment Application with the FCC.
- By August 1, 2021 – LSR and 5N close and consummate the sale.
- By August 1, 2021 – 5N places orders for required transmission equipment to build the CP.
- By October 1, 2021 – 5N receives all necessary transmission equipment. ➤ By November 15, 2021 – 5N completes the installation of all transmission equipment for the facility.
- By December 1, 2021 – 5N files license to cover application and commences operation of the station.

5N will give their best efforts to bring-forward these dates which may be subject to equipment and installation delays.
