

PUBLIC INSPECTION FILE

In preparing its license renewal filing, the station conducted an audit of its online public file. It determined that the following material was not timely uploaded to the online public file:

- 1Q 2016 Form 398 Children's Programming Report.
- 1Q 2018 Form 398 Children's Programming Report.
- 2Q 2015 Children's Programming Commercial Limits Certification.

In addition, the Form 398 Children's Programming Reports from 3Q 2015 through 4Q 2017 were timely filed but subsequently amended to provide programming information for WADL's secondary programming streams. Consequently, the Children's Programming Reports for 3Q 2015 through 4Q 2017 appear twice in WADL's online public inspection file. Also, until 4Q 2019, the station uploaded Children's Programming Commercial Limits Certifications that only addressed the FCC's website rule, rather than the rule limiting the number of commercial minutes included in children's programming targeted to kids 12 years old and younger. However, at all times during this license term, the only children's programming aired on WADL was targeted at kids 13 years old or older.

WADL timely filed its 2Q 2015 Issues/Programs Report, but the report appears twice in the station's online public inspection file. Station personnel do not recall re-uploading the 2Q 2015 report in October 2018 and suspect that it may appear twice due to an error or glitch in the database.

The station timely uploaded its 2019 EEO Public File Report. However, in the course of its online public file audit, the station discovered that an error had occurred that caused the report not to be visible to the public. WADL re-uploaded its 2019 EEO Public File Report to correct the issue.

The station's audit of its online public file also revealed that WADL did not file a Form 397 EEO Mid-Term Report in 2017 due to administrative oversight. However, WADL timely uploaded all of its annual EEO Public File Reports to its online public file. The Commission eliminated the Form 397 filing requirement in 2019.

Station WADL is committed to uploading political file material as soon as possible consistent with Commission guidance. In reviewing the political file material uploaded over the past two years, the station determined that a limited number of orders were not uploaded within one business day. Station management has implemented corrective measures, including training the staff responsible for uploading political material to the online file, to ensure that political material is now uploaded within one business day from a request for time.
