Dear Shaun:

I am responding to your email of June 14, 2021. The following is responsive to the questions posed.

WOOH-LD, Zanesville, Ohio (Facility ID No. 190268) resumed broadcast operations on May 27, 2020. It failed to file a Resumption of Operations. Furthermore, I have been advised that the station went dark in December of 2019, but did not request an STA.

With respect to WFGZ-LD, Lake City, Florida (Facility ID No. 189670), the station resumed broadcast operations on July 12, 2020, and filed a License to Cover on July 13, 2020. No Resumption of Operations notification was filed. I have been advised that the station went dark on October 4, 2019.

With respect to WJGC-LD, Greenville, North Carolina (Facility ID No. 189742), the station has been operating since July 11, 2020, which corresponds with the filing of a License to Cover (LMS File No. 000011769). No Resumption of Operations was filed. Furthermore, I have been advised that the station went dark on September 15, 2019.
