

Nueva Vida / New Life Assembly Inc. is a non-profit 501(c)(3) Taxpayer no. 1-75-266-7236-9 entity in the State of Texas was established to help the community with to learn about solving problems in the home, social services, adolescence issues as well as financial literacy. The organization includes research done from a variety of sources such as local, State and Federal programs. The organization stages workshops for young adults, teenagers, and the elderly and acts as a generational bridge. In addition, participants learn from our learning centers that we have placed throughout the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex.

The station's programming will primarily be a diverse range of inspirational music from cultures from all over the Latino world. The primary thrust will be to expose the community to music with positive talk shows in our area. We also plan to have teenagers hosting and producing shows under the guidance of experienced studio staff to teach them broadcast techniques and practices. We are also planning an oral history project in which older members of our Latino's community can come in the studios and share their life's experiences and to share in with their unique country of origin's culture. We plan to have regular on-air forums where local leaders answer questions on current issues and problems facing the community. Nueva Vida / New Life Assembly was incorporated in 1995.

The educational mission of Nueva Vida / New Life Assembly Inc. is to educate our community about the social issues that impact the community and to increase public awareness to the dangers of racism, violence in the community, the problems with gangs and drug abuse by constantly feeding the airwaves with family-oriented programming as well as sharing inspirational music and words of encouragement.
