Dear Applicant:

Based on information supplied, and assuming your operations will be as stated in your application for recognition of exemption, we have determined you are exempt from federal income tax under section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code as an organization described in section 501(c)(3).

We have further determined that you are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code, because you are an organization described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i).

If your sources of support, or your purposes, character, or method of operation change, please let us know so we can consider the effect of the change on your exempt status and foundation status. In the case of an amendment to your organizational document or bylaws, please send us a copy of the amended document or bylaws. Also, you should inform us of all changes in your name or address.

As of January 1, 1984, you are liable for taxes under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (social security taxes) on remuneration of \$100 or more you pay to each of your employees during a calendar year. This does not apply, however, if you make or have made a timely election under section 3121(w) of the Code to be exempt from such tax. You are not liable for the tax imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act (FUTA).

Since you are not a private foundation, you are not subject to the excise taxes under Chapter 42 of the Code. However, if you are involved in an excess benefit transaction, that transaction might be subject to the excise taxes of section 4958. Additionally, you are not automatically exempt from other federal excise taxes. If you have any questions about excise, employment, or other federal taxes, please contact your key district office.

Grantors and contributors may rely on this determination unless the Internal Revenue Service publishes notice to the contrary. However, if you lose your section 509(a)(1) status, a grantor or contributor may not rely on this determination if he or she was in part responsible for, or was aware of, the act or failure to act, or the substantial or material change on the part of the organization that resulted in the loss of such status, or if he or

she acquired knowledge that the Internal Revenue Service had given notice that you would no longer be classified as a section 509(a)(1) organization.

Donors may deduct contributions to you as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to you or for your use are deductible for federal estate and gift tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of Code sections 2055, 2106, and 2522.

Contribution deductions are allowable to donors only to the extent that their contributions are gifts, with no consideration received. Ticket purchases and similar payments in conjunction with fundraising events may not necessarily qualify as deductible contributions, depending on the circumstances. See Revenue Ruling 67-246, published in Cumulative Bulletin 1967-2, on page 104, which sets forth guidelines regarding the deductibility, as charitable contributions, of payments made by taxpayers for admission to or other participation in fundraising activities for charity.

In the heading of this letter we have indicated whether you must file Form 990, Return of Organization Exempt From Income Tax. If Yes is indicated, you are required to file Form 990 only if your gross receipts each year are normally more than \$25,000. However, if you receive a Form 990 package in the mail, please file the return even if you do not exceed the gross receipts test. If you are not required to file, simply attach the label provided, check the box in the heading to indicate that your annual gross receipts are normally \$25,000 or less, and sign the return.

If a return is required, it must be filed by the 15th day of the fifth month after the end of your annual accounting period. A penalty of \$20 a day is charged when a return is filed late, unless there is reasonable cause for the delay. However, the maximum penalty charged cannot exceed \$10,000 or 5 percent of your gross receipts for the year, whichever is less. For organizations with gross receipts exceeding \$1,000,000 in any year, the penalty is \$100 per day per return, unless there is reasonable cause for the delay. The maximum penalty for an organization with gross receipts exceeding \$1,000,000 shall not exceed \$50,000. This penalty may also be charged if a return is not complete, so be sure your return is complete before you file it.

The law requires you to make your annual return available for public inspection without charge for three years after the due date of the return. You are also required to make available for public inspection a copy of your exemption application, any supporting documents and this exemption letter to any individual who requests such documents in person or in writing. You can charge only a reasonable fee for reproduction and actual postage costs for the copied materials. The law does not require you to provide copies of public inspection documents that are made widely available, such as by posting them on the Internet (World Wide Web). You may be liable for a penalty of \$20 a day for each day you do not make these documents available for public inspection (up to a maximum of \$10,000 in the case of an annual return).

You are not required to file federal income tax returns unless you are

subject to the tax on unrelated business income under section 511 of the Code. If you are subject to this tax, you must file an income tax return on Form 990-T, Exempt Organization Business Income Tax Return. In this letter we are not determining whether any of your present or proposed activities are unrelated trade or business as defined in section 513 of the Code.

You need an employer identification number even if you have no employees. If an employer identification number was not entered on your application, a number will be assigned to you and you will be advised of it. Please use that number on all returns you file and in all correspondence with the Internal Revenue Service.

In accordance with section 508(a) of the Code, the effective date of this determination letter is March 24, 1999.

This determination is based on evidence that your funds are dedicated to the purposes listed in section 501(c)(3) of the Code. To assure your continued exemption, you should keep records to show that funds are expended only for those purposes. If you distribute funds to other organizations, your records should show whether they are exempt under section 501(c)(3). In cases where the recipient organization is not exempt under section 501(c)(3), there should be evidence that the funds will remain dedicated to the required purposes and that they will be used for those purposes by the recipient.

If distributions are made to individuals, case histories regarding the recipients should be kept showing names, addresses, purposes of awards, manner of selection, relationship (if any) to members, officers, trustees or donors of funds to you, so that any and all distributions made to individuals can be substantiated upon request by the Internal Revenue Service. (Revenue Ruling 56-304, C.B. 1956-2, page 306.)



I am pleased to report that Nueva Vida/New Life Assembly, Inc., Taxpayer No. 1-75-2667236-9, qualifies for exemption from the franchise tax as a 501(c)(3) organization effective March 24, 1999. Since the account is in the process of being updated, you should disregard any franchise tax notices for periods covered by the exemption. In the event we have reason to believe the organization no longer qualifies for exemption, we will notify the registered agent that the exempt status is under review.

This corporation also qualifies for exemption from the state and local sales taxes effective March 24, 1999, as a 501(c)(3) organization. It may now issue an exemption certificate instead of paying the sales tax on taxable items if they relate to the purpose of the exempt organization and are not used for the personal benefit of a private stockholder or individual. The certificate does not require a number to be valid and may be reproduced in any quantity.

We will consider reclassifying this corporation's basis for exemption to religious if you provide evidence that shows the organization is engaged primarily in holding and conducting religious worship. Include a photocopy of the Articles of Incorporation, the street address and a description of the facilities of where services are held, the times of the weekly services, the approximate number of persons attending services, any advertising such as a bulletin, a newsletter, a copy of a newspaper advertisement or listing in the telephone directory, a photocopy of the Statement of Faith or Beliefs, a photocopy of order of worship services, and if your church is a member of a common denomination or a convention of churches that has a group exemption under the Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3), please provide verification from the parent organization that your church is a recognized subordinate. If your church is an independent church or a non-denomination church, please let us know. You may send your information to my attention at the Exempt Organizations Section, P.O. Box 13528, Austin, Texas 78711-3528.

If the organization makes any sales of taxable items or services, please contact our Tax Assistance Section at 1-800-252-5555 to determine if a sales tax permit is needed. The regular number is 512/463-4600.

If the organization changes its name, registered agent or registered office address, it is required to notify the Secretary of State.

**I, the undersigned natural person, over the age of eighteen (18) years, acting as an incorporator adopt the following Articles of Incorporation of NUEVA VIDA/NEW LIFE ASSEMBLY INC., A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, hereinafter referred to as the Corporation, under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act:**

**ARTICLE ONE**

**NAME**

**The name of the Corporation is NUEVA VIDA/NEW LIFE ASSEMBLY, INC.**

**ARTICLE TWO**

**NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION**

**The Corporation is a nonprofit Corporation. Upon dissolution, all of the Corporation's assets shall be distributed to the State of Texas or an organization exempt from taxes under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) for one or more purpose that exempt under the Texas franchise tax.**

**ARTICLE THREE**

**DURATION**

**The period of the Corporation's duration is perpetual.**

**ARTICLE FOUR**

**PURPOSES**

**The purpose for which this Corporation is organized is:**

**To promote, teach, preach, the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. To better equip the Body of Christ (the church) to become honest, law abiding citizens, better parents, better ministers of the Word of God.**

## **ARTICLE FIVE**

### **POWERS**

Except as otherwise provided in these Articles, the Corporation shall have all of the powers provided in the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act. More over, the Corporation shall have implied powers necessary and proper to carry out its expressed powers. The Corporation shall have no power to take any action that would be inconsistent with the requirements for tax exemption under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) and related regulations, rulings, and procedures. The Corporation shall have no power to take any action that would be inconsistent with the requirements for receiving tax deductible charitable contributions under Internal Revenue Code Section 170(c)(2) and related regulations, rulings and procedures.

## **ARTICLE SIX**

### **MEMBERSHIP**

The Corporation shall have one or more classes of members as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

## **ARTICLE SEVEN**

### **INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT**

## **ARTICLE EIGHT**

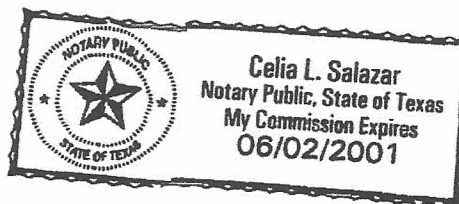


