FORM 2100 COVERING LICENSE APPLICATION  
SPECIAL OPERATING CONDITIONS ##1-2

We hereby respectfully request that the Commission grant program test authority for KEJJ(FM)'s operations granted in File No. BPH- BPH-20180503ABP.

The KEJJ transmitter site is located near the top of "W" Mountain, southeast of Gunnison, Colorado. The site is owned by Western Colorado University (WCU). In "good" conditions the drive on this access road to the KVLE-FM transmitter site can take 75 minutes and is advisable only for four-wheel drive vehicles with a high clearance. Between October 15 and April 15, the road is closed due to the heavy snows that occur in the autumn and winter months.

About 3 miles from the top, there is signage that the site is private property and that a radio hazard exists. At about one-half mile from the top there is a locked gate upon which is posted a radiofrequency electromagnetic field hazard sign, the size of which is approximately 4 feet tall by 4 feet wide. At the KVLE-FM transmitter building on the transmitter site, there are two more hazard warning signs.

Therefore, there is no RF radiation hazard to humans at the authorized transmitter site, because (1) it is on a mountain peak; (2) no humans live nearby; (3) the access road is a difficult drive in warmer months and impassible in the snowy months; and (4) there are warning signage and a locked gate on the one primitive road that leads to the site.
