Local Media San Diego Acquisition, LLC (“LMSD”) consummated its purchase of the KFMB-FM radio station (now, KFBG) from Tegna Television, Inc on March 17, 2020. Just two days later, on March 19, 2020, the Governor of California signed an executive order, mandating a state-wide shutdown policy due to the spread of COVID-19.

As a result of the Governor’s order and the unforeseen economic effects of the pandemic, LMSD placed in its public file on June 30, 2020 a letter indicating that it had imposed an indefinite freeze on hiring employees. Due to the timing of LMSD’s acquisition of KFBG and LMSD’s uncertainty regarding its filing obligations during the pandemic and its hiring freeze, LMSD was not aware that it was required to submit an Annual EEO Public File Report for the period ending July 31, 2020. Once it understood the applicability of this obligation, LMSD promptly prepared and posted on its website and public file on June 24, 2021 an Annual EEO Public File Report encompassing its ownership of KFBG from the period of March 17, 2020 to July 31, 2020.

LMSD has since timely posted on its website and public file an Annual EEO Public File Report for the period ending July 31, 2021 and has engaged with counsel to establish written reminders for this and other key filing deadlines going forward.
