

Online Public Inspection File

Note the following regarding the “No” response to this certification: “Licensee certifies that the documentation required by 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3526 or 73.3527, as applicable, has been uploaded to the station’s public inspection file as and when required.”

Noncommercial educational radio stations such as KALW(FM), San Francisco, California, were required to transition their paper public inspection files to the FCC’s online public inspection file (“OPIF”) by March 1, 2018. While all the KALW Quarterly Issues-Programs Lists for the subject license term have been uploaded to KALW’s OPIF, due to learning-curve difficulties in the uploading process, several of the pre-2018 Quarterly Issues-Programs Lists were uploaded later in March 2018, or, in a handful of instances, in 2019. Uploads for the 2018 Quarterly Issues-Programs Lists were untimely in three instances. A regular uploading routine has since been established, so that the 2019, 2020, and (to date) 2021 Quarterly Issues-Programs Lists have been uploaded to the KALW OPIF by, or within one day of, the respective quarterly deadline.
