Re: Analog License Cancellations

Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to the former stations listed in the attached Appendix. Section 74.731(m) of the Commission's rules provides that:

After 11:59 p.m. local time, [][July 13, 2021], low power television and TV translator stations may no longer operate any facility in analog (NTSC) mode and all licenses for such analog operations shall automatically cancel at that time without any affirmative action by the Commission.<sup>1</sup>

Commission records indicate that you failed to file a digital construction permit for the stations and their licenses automatically canceled at 12:00 A.M. (local time) on July 14, 2021.<sup>2</sup>

Accordingly, pursuant to section 74.731 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 74.731(m), the licenses for the stations listed in the attached Appendix were **AUTOMATICALLY CANCELED**, their call signs have been **DELETED**, and any pending applications have been **DISMISSED**.<sup>3</sup> All authority to operate the stations has been **TERMINATED**<sup>4</sup> and any operation of these facilities **MUST CEASE IMMEDIATELY**.<sup>5</sup>
