Dear Former Licensee:

This is with respect to the above captioned former station. Section 74.731(m) of the Commission's rules provides that:

After 11:59 p.m. local time, [][July 13, 2021], low power television and TV translator stations may no longer operate any facility in analog (NTSC) mode and all licenses for such analog operations shall automatically cancel at that time without any affirmative action by the Commission.¹

Commission records indicate that while you were granted a digital construction permit, you failed to file a license to cover by its expiration date.² As such the station's construction permit was automatically forfeited and its license automatically cancelled at 12:00 A.M. (local time) on July 14, 2021.

Accordingly, pursuant to sections 74.788(b) and 74.731(m) of the Commission's rules,³ the construction permit and license for the above captioned station were **AUTOMATICALLY FORFEITED/CANCELED** and its call sign has been **DELETED**.⁴ All authority to operate the station has been **TERMINATED**⁵ and any operation of the facility **MUST CEASE IMMEDIATELY**.⁶
