

Compliance with Special Operating Conditions

Translator K264DA was constructed in compliance with all Special Operating Conditions except for Condition Number 1. Special Operating Condition Number 1 is in error. KREB (AM) and KFFK (AM) are not directional stations, so it is not necessary to conduct partial proofs of performance for the two AM stations.

The K264DA antenna is mounted at its permitted height of 43 meters AGL on the partially disassembled AM tower (ASR 1058573) of KREB (AM) and KFFK (AM). KREB (AM) and KFFK (AM) are operating at the site, but are not using the partially disassembled tower as a radiator. Instead, the AM stations are utilizing an emergency long wire antenna and have requested Special Temporary Authority. Since the AM stations are operating with an emergency long wire antenna, it is pointless to make impedance measurements on the deactivated tower. Both of these stations have construction permits to relocate to a new, independent site. These AM stations will never return to this deactivated tower.
