

Request for Extension of Time to Consummate Transaction

Bravo Mic Communications, LLC (“Bravo Mic”) respectfully requests an extension of time to consummate the transaction described below and to file notice thereof with the Commission. On April 16, 2021, Luna County Broadcasting Company (“Luna”) filed an application to assign radio broadcast stations KOTS and KDEM (“Stations”) from Luna to Bravo Mic (Luna and Bravo Mic collectively “the Parties”), LMS File No. 0000142153. On May 27, 2021, the Commission granted that application and issued an Assignment Authorization (“Authorization”). The Authorization stated that “[g]rant of this application is subject to the condition that the transaction proposed herein be consummated by June 1, 2021. If consummation does not occur prior to June 1, 2021, the transaction may not be consummated until after the license for the station has been renewed.” In addition, the Authorization required the Parties to consummate the transaction within 90 days of the date the Authorization was issued.

The Parties were unable to consummate the transaction before June 1, 2021 and the Stations’ licenses have not yet been renewed. In addition, the Authorization’s 90 day consummation deadline is set to expire on August 25, 2021. Prior to the expiration of this August 25, 2021 deadline, the Stations’ licenses will not be renewed in the ordinary course and the Parties will therefore not be able to consummate the approved assignment. Accordingly, and pursuant to the terms in the Authorization, Bravo Mic respectfully requests a 90-day extension, to November 24, 2021, to consummate the transaction and file notice thereof with the Commission. Luna consents to the filing of this request.
