Online Public Inspection File

Out of an abundance of caution, Oregon State University, licensee of noncommercial educational radio station KBVR(FM), reports the following with regard to the timely placement of documents into the station's public inspection files. The station's online public inspection file is complete with all required items, and all items were added when originally due to the station's paper public inspection file or the station's online public inspection file, as applicable over the course of the current license term; however, as of the March 2018 deadline to transition from the paper public file to the online public inspection file, the station had only transferred issues and programs lists dating back to the 2nd quarter of 2016. Once the station became aware of this issue in 2019, it also transferred to the online public file its previously prepared issues and programs lists dating back to the 1st quarter of 2014, which had been part of the station's paper public file at the studio location. Although these items were added to the public file when originally due, and the online public file is now complete with all required materials, the station regrets the delay in their transfer to the online public inspection file.
