

### **KTBH-FM Online Public Inspection File**

During the last license renewal period, Resonate Hawaii, LLC (“Licensee”), licensee of KTBH-FM, Kurtistown, Hawaii (Facility ID No. 164281) (“Station”), cannot certify full compliance with Station’s Online Public Inspection File (“OPIF”) requirements.

**Section 73.3613 Contracts/Documents List.** Licensee inadvertently failed to upload the contracts and documents required by Section 73.3613 of the Commission’s rules to Station’s OPIF. Upon discovering this oversight, Licensee immediately uploaded the required documents.

**Issues/Programs Lists.** Station failed to timely upload a number of its quarterly Issues/Programs Lists. Upon discovery of lists that were not uploaded by the deadline, Station promptly uploaded the relevant list. All of Station’s required Issues/Programs lists have now been uploaded to the OPIF.

Licensee fully appreciates its obligation to comply with the Commission’s rules and has taken steps to ensure Issues/Programs Lists are timely uploaded going forward. In addition, Licensee will reemphasize to Station staff the importance of following Licensee’s policies and procedures related to OPIF maintenance. Licensee is confident that the procedures it has adopted regarding Issues/Programs List compliance will mean that future lists are timely uploaded to the OPIF.

**Political File.** Station failed to timely upload information related to the political ads it accepted in 2020. Licensee regrets this oversight. Station accepted more than five political ads in 2020 that were uploaded late to the OPIF. While there was some industry-wide confusion related to the Commission’s requirement that political ad information be uploaded to the OPIF within one business day, Licensee appreciates its obligation to fully comply with the Commission’s rules. Therefore, Licensee has adopted additional procedures to ensure Station staff routinely upload political ad information within one business day. Licensee believes these new procedures will ensure Licensee fulfills its commitment to fully comply with the Commission’s political file rules going forward.
