Change in Virtual Channel Assignment

Dear Mr. Hashemzadeh:

DTV America Corporation ("DTV") is the licensee of Low Power TV station WUDW-LD, Richmond, VA, Facility ID No. 182288 ("WUDW"). WUDW has been operating under Virtual Channel 15.<sup>1</sup> By this letter, DTV respectfully requests Virtual Channel 53 in lieu of Virtual Channel 15. An analysis of the surrounding area/market indicates that Virtual Channel 53 is available for use by WUDW and would not conflict with any another station's Virtual Channel assignment. It is noted that the public interest is served by these changes in Virtual Channel assignments because it would avoid a conflict with full power TV station WHRO-TV, Channel 31, Virtual Channel 15, Hampton-Norfolk, VA, Facility ID No. 25932.
