

## Curry Coast Community Radio Nexus Between Program Plans and Corporate Purposes

The Articles of Incorporation of Curry Coast Community Radio (“CCCR”), October 1, 2013, *Attachment A* are purely generic insofar as any mission statement. However, the entity has adopted specific by law provisions that spell out in detail the educational radio aims of the organization (excerpt, *Attachment B*). These include an express purpose regarding listener supported noncommercial radio, Article 3.03: “. . . to provide a powerful public forum, lending voice to local cultures, art, education, entertainment and government working together to bring peace, justice, harmony, and prosperity to all the people of Curry County, Oregon.”

In furtherance of these goals, CCCR applied for and secured the license for a lower power FM station, KCIW-LP, BLL-20161219AAO. A description of the program services provided by KCIW-LP is *Attachment C*. The applicant here represents that, if granted a noncommercial educational authorization, it will employ that authority to offer, on an expended basis, exactly the types of base line program services it now provides through KCIW-LP, with other possible noncommercial educational program services to be developed in the future.
