

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

The applicant, Weimar Institute (dba. Weimar University), is a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of California in 1977. Weimar Institute is an educational institution located in Northern California. It has been in continuous operation since 1977, with a focus on innovative education that focused on a practical education that encompassed the whole person, not just the mind, but the body, and the emotional being as well. It is listed among the top nursing programs in California. It is unique in that it is the only institution in the state which requires an academically rigorous course on developing habits of life which optimize brain function. It has been preparing medical missionaries to be an important part of assisting in the health of their communities. It has produces graduates with a vision to "heal a broken world." It offers both undergraduate and graduate degrees and has seen steady growth each year.

The applicant has the following educational objectives:

1. To provide religious instruction and moral teaching.
2. To teach parents and children principles for strengthening the home.
3. To help members of the community discover solutions to the personal, social, relational and health problems typical of contemporary times.
4. To provide opportunity for and to promote discussion of all areas of family, contemporary social, religious and personal life issues.
5. To teach the ideals of citizenship, integrity, personal responsibility, moral rectitude and spiritual maturity.

To further those educational objectives, the applicant proposes to present a variety of programming to inform, entertain, stimulate and educate the audience in the proposed service area. The programming will be directed to listeners of all backgrounds in an effort to instill a sense of harmony and cooperation among all members of the community.

Subject matter covered by programming will include family development, child rearing and education, health information and religion. Programs will be developed and selected so as to be responsive to the needs and interests in the proposed service area.
