

FCC EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM EXHIBIT

The purpose of this exhibit is to demonstrate Activist San Diego/KNSJ's educational objectives and that the proposed radio station will be used for the advancement of an educational program under 73.503(a) of the Rules. The rules describe that noncommercial licenses are not limited to classroom instruction, but may "transmit educational, cultural, and entertainment programs to the general public," (Section 73.503(b)) in the advancement of a radio program. The following clearly demonstrates Activist San Diego/KNSJ's eligibility:

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVE

Activist San Diego/ DBA KNSJ is a tax-exempt educational corporation under section 501(c)(3) of the IRS code. Within its Articles of Incorporation, it states the purpose of Activist San Diego/KNSJ is in part to be an educational organization within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code by educating the public on issues and educating the public. The corporation's objective is well in-line with the qualification of being considered an educational nonprofit.

PAST EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Activist San Diego / DBA KNSJ has educated and advocated on behalf of citizen journalists, as well as others who use communication platforms like academics and community based activists, for 22 years.

We have over our long existence as a nonprofit organization:

- Convened hundreds of events, forums and workshops focusing on issues of interest to the community and civic goals of the region.
- Trained residents in media skills, including computer skills, writing skills, spokesperson training and media outreach
- Advocated on behalf of grassroots workers in municipal, regional and state forums in San Diego County and Imperial County, California (and occasionally national forums) around civic affairs of interest to the community.

PROPOSED EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

Activist San Diego/KNSJ intends to utilize the proposed facility to extend its educational mission to the airwaves by carrying:

- * Debates, independent news, and issues of concern to the communications sector
- * Cultural programming featuring independent and grassroots voices

The radio programs will expand our current programs to help more fully actualize our original intent as described in our Articles of Incorporation.
