

## **Engineering Special Temporary Authority Extension Request**

HC2 LPTV Holdings, Inc. (“Licensee”) respectfully requests an Engineering Special Temporary Authority (STA) extension request pursuant to the technical specifications listed in the application.

***Public Interest Benefits.*** The station’s transmitter is unable to make full power and is currently producing 4.9kW Effective Radiated Power. On 12 May 2021, it was identified that the transmitter’s controller reading indicated low output with high reflective power. The local engineer worked with the antenna manufacturer to diagnose the issue. The station requested an Engineering STA, FCC File Number: 0000147248, which was granted on 26 May 2021. The station has worked diligently to resolve the antenna concern by purchasing and receiving a new antenna. The station filed for and received a Minor Modification grant, FCC File Number: 0000164742, on 25 October 2021 to install the new antenna. The station has worked with the tower company to update the lease and is currently waiting to receive a Notice to Proceed (NTP) from the tower owner to begin installation of the new antenna. Once the NTP is received, the rigging crew will be scheduled to facilitate the installation of the new antenna.

Grant of Licensee’s Engineering STA extension request promotes the public interest as it will allow KRZG-CD to continue to provide free over-the-air programming to the community and the surrounding area in the interim, prior to the installation of the new antenna.

***Conclusion.*** Licensee respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Engineering STA extension for KRZG-CD.
