

WXLM(AM) Renewal Certification Exhibit

The ultimate parent of the licensee, Cumulus Media Inc. (“Cumulus”), as well as various other direct and indirect wholly-owned subsidiaries, emerged from a Chapter 11 bankruptcy proceeding on May 10, 2018. As a result, the station which is the subject of this renewal application was transferred to the licensee on June 4, 2018 pursuant to a long-form transfer of control application (File No. BTC-20180322ALP) following Cumulus’ emergence from bankruptcy. Therefore, the license term with respect to this station commenced on June 4, 2018.¹

Online Public Inspection File

On July 22, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order* and *Consent Decree* (DA 20-776)² in which Cumulus agreed to report any violations of Section 73.1943(c) of the Commission’s Rules. Cumulus reports that, since the effective date of the *Order* and *Consent Decree*, there have been no violations of this rule.

All quarterly issues/programs lists were uploaded into the online public file on a timely basis except for Q.3 in 2018. In addition, one EEO public file report was uploaded late.

Those station employees who have responsibility for preparing and maintaining the documentation required to be uploaded to the station’s online public file have been reminded of the FCC’s requirements with respect to these matters and have implemented procedures to ensure that the required documentation will contain all of the appropriate information and will be placed in the station’s online public file in a timely manner going forward.
