

Compliance with Special Operating Conditions or Restrictions

The applicant in coordination with other users of the site is committed to reducing power or ceasing operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines. Further, the Applicant commits to complying with any special operating conditions or restrictions listed on the construction permit which requires no action or specific response at licensing. Required responses to listed special conditions or restrictions are listed below.

- The filing of the instant application for license (FCC Form 2100, Schedule 350) allows for the commencement of program test operations and satisfies the listed special condition.
- The installation of the FM antenna described herein did not result in a significant modification of the existing tower as defined in Section 1.30002(d) of the Commission's Rules. The translator antenna is mounted on a grounded tower that is not base-insulated or detuned at any AM frequency. Further, the Chief Engineer of WIBW(AM), Topeka, KS, Fac. ID No. 63169, has confirmed that the translator installation has had no adverse effect on the WIBW(AM) directional antenna array.
