PENDING AND RESOLVED DISCRIMINATION COMPLAINTS

During the preceding license term, Station KDEN-TV has been the subject of the following pending or resolved discrimination complaints:

1. Miguel Bedoy v. KDEN – Telemundo of Denver, LLC: Complaint of discrimination – sexual orientation, national origin and retaliation filed 3/26/2020 with the EEOC / Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies (Case No. E2000008114). Status: EEOC dismissed due to early right to sue request.
2. Edgardi Adriana Macias v. KDEN – Telemundo of Denver, LLC: Complaint of discrimination – gender, national origin, disability and retaliation filed 3/27/2020 with the EEOC / Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies (Case No. 32A-2020-00400). Status: EEOC dismissed due to early right to sue request.
3. Bedoy et al. v. NBCUniversal Media, LLC et al.: Complaint of hostile work environment, discrimination, mental anguish/emotional distress, lost wages, and retaliation filed 8/24/20, with the United States District Court for the District of Colorado (Case No. 1:20-cv-02548). Status: Administratively closed. Currently in arbitration.
4. Clara Trullenque v. KDEN – Telemundo of Denver, LLC: Complaint of gender, national origin discrimination and discrimination under the ADA filed 10/29/2020 with the EEOC / Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies – Civil Rights Division (Case No.: EEOC No. 32A-2021-00065 / FEPA No. R2100010179). Status: Pending, respondent filed demand for arbitration.
