

Non-Pro Forma Assignment Application
Assignee – Multiple Ownership Compliance

Except for KSLT, which is addressed below, the other full power stations that are part of the proposed transaction are noncommercial, and therefore do not implicate the FCC's radio station ownership restrictions. *See* 47 CFR §73.3555(f).

KSLT, the only commercial full power station involved in this transaction, is not assigned to an Arbitron rated market, and therefore the Commission's interim contour overlap method is to be used to measure compliance with the multiple ownership rules. KSLT's principal community contour does not overlap with the principal community contours of any commercial full power radio station in which the proposed assignee and its related parties to the application have an attributable interest, and therefore, the FCC's multiple ownership rules are not implicated by the proposed assignment of KSLT.
