

Renewal of License – TV Translator/LPTV Certifications, Discontinued Operations Narrative

K21OM-D initiated operations in Lafayette, LA, Facility: 183746, when it filed a License to Cover application, FCC File Number: 0000014028, on 9/19/2016.

In addition to the periods of silence noted in the Adherence to Minimum Operating Schedule Narrative¹, the station went silent on 11/29/2017 and a Silent Special Temporary Authority (“Silent STA”) request was filed on 12/14/2017, FCC File Number: 0000036342, and granted on 12/14/2017. The reason for the period of silence was that HC2 Broadcasting, as the new controlling owner of the station, took the station off-air to review its operational status going forward. The station filed an Silent STA extension request on 6/11/2018 which remains pending, FCC File Number: 0000055122. The station resumed operations on 10/22/2018 and filed a resumption of operations notice, FCC File Number: 0000063027.

The station went silent on 11/6/2018 and a Silent STA request, FCC File Number: 0000063453, was filed on 11/12/2018 and granted on 11/12/2018. The reason for the period of silence was that the station was undertaking efforts to construct its permanent broadcast facility pursuant to the granted Displacement application, FCC File Number: 0000051598. Additionally, DTV America Corporation was operating in a resource-constrained environment due to the 600 MHz Incentive Auction repacking process. Station owners, particularly LPTV station owners which were deemed lower priority, that were seeking to build new broadcast facilities had access to far fewer resources such as tower crews and equipment than they would have had otherwise, a factor that the Commission and the Media Bureau acknowledged.²

The station filed an Silent STA extension request, FCC File Number: 0000072355, on 5/3/2019 while it continued its efforts to construct its permanent displaced broadcast facility. The Licensee added new team members to facilitate the planning, design and construction of new facilities and diligently prepared site summaries and sketches, whilst completing the engineering design process and evaluating its Internet options for content delivery. The station was in contact with transmitter manufacturers and collecting quotes from vendors to complete construction.

The station duly filed a Section 312(g) waiver request on 11/7/2019, FCC File Number: 0000072355, as amended, which was granted by letter decision on 3/23/2020.³ In the grant, Commission staff noted, “Consistent with the public interest and prior Bureau actions, we will provide section 312(g) relief to displaced LPTV and TV translator stations that were displaced by the Incentive Auction and pursued new displacement channels.”

The station resumed operations when it filed a License to Cover application on 2/12/2020, FCC File Number: 0000105971, which was granted on 4/23/2020. Since that date, the station has been operating pursuant to authorized specifications except as otherwise noted herein.
