

## **Renewal of License Amendment – Adherence to Minimum Operating Schedule Narrative**

DTV America Corporation acquired the license for WCTZ-LD, Facility ID: 182481, Bowling Green, KY, on 8/20/2013, upon consummation of an assignment application, FCC File Number: BAPDTL-20130614ABR. At the time of consummation, the station was operating pursuant to a License to Cover, FCC File Number: BLDTL-20131211AWZ, granted 12/17/2013.

The station went silent on 2/15/2015 and filed a Silent Special Temporary Authority (“Silent STA”) request on 2/19/2015, FCC File Number: BLSTA-20150219AAH, which was accepted for filing. The reason for the period of silence was outlined in the Media Bureau’s *DTV America Corporation et al.*, Consent Decree, 32 FCC Rcd 9129 (MB rel. Oct. 31, 2017) (“Consent Decree”).

The station resumed operations on 12/15/2015 and filed a Resumption of Operations, FCC File Number: 0000007744, on 1/11/2016.

The station went silent on 2/20/2016 and filed a Silent STA request, FCC File Number: 0000008192, on 2/25/2016. The reason for the period of silence was outlined in the Consent Decree. The Silent STA was granted 2/25/2016.

The station resumed operations when it filed a License to Cover application on 3/10/2016, FCC File Number: 0000008346. The License to Cover was granted on 3/18/2016.

The station went silent on 3/18/2016 and filed a Silent STA request, FCC File Number: 0000008432, on 3/18/2016. The reason for the period of silence was outlined in the Consent Decree. The Silent STA was granted on 3/18/2016.

The station filed a Silent STA extension on 9/12/2016, FCC File Number: 0000013971. The reason for the extended period of silence is outlined in the Consent Decree. The Silent STA extension was dismissed on 2/4/2020.

The station resumed operations on 1/18/2017 and filed a Resumption of Operations, FCC File Number: 0000021390, on 1/18/2017.

The station went silent on 1/18/2017 and filed a Silent STA request, FCC File Number: 0000021463, on 1/20/2017. The reason for the period of silence was outlined in the Consent Decree. The Silent STA was granted on 1/20/2017.

The station extended the Silent STA on 7/18/2017, FCC File Number: 0000028956. The reason for the Silent STA extension is outlined in the Consent Decree. The Silent STA extension was granted 2/4/2020.

HC2 Broadcasting acquired majority control of the license for WCTZ-LD, Facility: 182481, Bowling Green, KY, pursuant to a transfer of control application as part of the Media Bureau’s *DTV America Corporation et al.*, Consent Decree, 32 FCC Rcd (MB rel. Oct. 31, 2017) (“Consent Decree”). The acquisition was consummated on 11/9/2017.

The Transferor was DTV America Corporation. The Lead File Number was: BTCDTL-20170714ABI and the Member File Number was: BTCDTL-20170714ACW.

The station resumed operation on 1/16/2018 and filed a Resumption of Operations, FCC File Number: 0000040388, on 1/18/2018.

The station went silent on 1/16/2018 and filed a Silent STA request on 1/19/2018, FCC File Number: 0000040445. The reason for the period of silence was due to the transfer of control of DTV America to HC2 Broadcasting Inc. (“HC2”), and the subsequent complications of transitioning to new leadership. The transaction was consummated on November 9, 2017 and involved more than 400 LPTV stations.<sup>1</sup> HC2 was in the process of surveying its resources and developing construction and operational plans. Additionally, HC2, as the new majority owner of DTV America, was operating in a resource-constrained environment due to the 600 MHz Incentive Auction repacking process. Station owners, particularly LPTV station owners which were deemed lower priority, that were seeking to build new broadcast facilities had access to far fewer resources such as tower crews and equipment than they would have had otherwise, a factor that the Commission and the Media Bureau acknowledged.<sup>2</sup> The Silent STA was granted on 1/19/2018.

The station filed a Silent STA extension request on 7/5/2018, FCC File Number: 0000056103. The specific reason for the extended period of silence was that HC2 was continuing to examine its location options for this facility.

The station resumed operations on 10/25/2018 and filed a Resumption of Operations, FCC File Number: 0000063207, on 10/31/2018.

The station went silent on 10/25/2018 and filed a Silent STA request, FCC File Number: 0000063222, on 10/31/2018. The specific reason for the silence was that the station was building its new facility pursuant to the granted Minor Modification, FCC File Number: 0000021775. The Silent STA was granted 10/31/2018.

The station filed an extension to the Silent STA request on 4/23/2019, FCC File Number 0000072126. The reason for the extended period of silence was continuing to build its new facility outlined in Minor Modification, FCC File Number: 0000021775.

The station resumed operations on 5/2/2019 when it filed a License to Cover application 5/2/2019, FCC File Number 0000072298. The License to Cover was granted 5/6/2019. Since that date, the station has been operating pursuant to its authorized specifications since 5/6/2019.
