Aaniiih Nakoda College is the Licensee of noncommercial educational station KGVA(FM). KGVA serves the Fort Belknap Indian Reservation and surrounding community as Montana's "first native radio station."

KGVA serves the educational, informational and cultural needs of Indians and non-Indians, both on the Reservation and in the nearby communities. KGVA serves over 25,000 people in a coverage area of 9,491 square miles.

KGVA serves four purposes:

- (1) To bring National Public Radio to this large unserved area;
- (2) To provide a key emergency alerting system to service this windy region beset by climate extremes;
- (3) To promote the educational mission of Aaniiih Nakoda College; and
- (4) To increase the social and economic well-being by facilitating interaction between Indian and non-Indian communities.

Station personnel have suffered numerous health challenges including but not limited to the COVID-19 pandemic. Although KGVA's Station Manager had been working diligently to locate and/or re-create the Quarterly Issues/Programs Lists both before and after the license renewal application was filed, unfortunately, he passed away on July 6, 2021. Since that time, an Interim Station Manager has done his best to complete the task, but he has been unable to achieve complete success.

Specifically, the station was unable to locate or recreate files for the following quarters: 2013 Q2-Q4; 2015 Q1, Q3, and Q4; and 2016 Q1 and Q2. Files related to all other quarters during the current renewal period (i.e., 2014 – present) have now been uploaded to the station's online public file.
