Re: Digital Flash Cut Construction Permit Application

Dear Licensee:

According to Commission records the station listed below has already completed its conversion to digital operations using the digital companion channel facility referenced below. Analog stations were provided the option to complete their transition to digital by either (1) "flash cutting" their existing analog facility to digital (at which time their analog license will be replaced by a new digital license and the digital companion channel permit or license canceled) or (2) surrendering their analog channel and continuing to operate their digital companion channel. For stations choosing the second option, analog channels were required to be surrendered no later than July 13, 2021. No station may possess both a digital flash cut and digital companion channel construction permit.¹

Accordingly, the following digital flash cut application has been **DISMISSED** and the corresponding analog facility has been **CANCELED**. The station may continue to operate the digital facility listed below.
