

Amendment – KXLF

This amendment to the instant application is being filed to reflect the new broadcast television Table of Allotments that was updated effective December 22, 2021. Specifically, the requested channel change for Butte, Montana is as follows:

<u>Present</u>	<u>Proposed</u>
5, 19, 20, 24	15, 19, 20, 24

In addition, this requested channel change is one of six channel change requests being filed contemporaneously by Scripps Broadcasting Holdings LLC (“Scripps”). As detailed in the accompanying Engineering Report, the loss areas created by this channel change are partially covered by other Scripps stations that are also filing channel change requests. Specifically, the contour of Scripps stations KPAX-TV (Missoula, MT), KBZK (Bozeman, MT) and KRTV (Great Falls, MT) partially cover the loss area created here. One other low power Scripps station, KXLH-LD (Helena, MT) also partially covers the loss area. Because the loss area is sparsely populated, the number of persons in the loss area remains the same when reviewing the KXLF channel change proposal using the current contours of the other Scripps stations or the station contours after they will be when the KPAX-TV, KBZK and KRTV channel changes are effectuated. In both cases, the loss area is calculated to be 139 persons, which is *de minimis*. The Scripps low power station, KXLH-LD, is not changing channels.
