

Public File Certification

The KPTS online public inspection file is now complete, with all items required to be placed in the file by 47 C.F.R. 73.3526, to the licensee's knowledge. However, over the course of the preceding license term, the station failed to upload certain required files in a timely manner (*e.g.*, the station's issues and programs lists for the second quarter of 2015, the first quarter of 2017, the second quarter of 2018, the third and fourth quarter of 2019, and the second quarter of 2021).¹ Since discovering this issue, the problem has been corrected and licensee has put into place procedures that will ensure that it timely files all subsequent documents to the station's online public file.

Licensee believes that as of the filing of the instant application its online public file is now complete. In making this certification, the licensee has reviewed its public inspection file and has inquired of current employees who are knowledgeable of the contents and maintenance of the licensee's public inspection file. As used in this certification, the phrase "to licensee's knowledge" means licensee's actual knowledge, during the period that the licensee has owned the station, without further investigation other than as described in this exhibit.

¹ In preparing this license renewal application, Licensee has determined that many of its issues/programs lists include erroneous file names which do not correspond to the quarter covered by the document. Licensee has not endeavored to rename these files, as the period covered by each report is accurately reflected at the beginning of each document.
