Public Inspection File

The Station completed its EEO Annual Report for 2017-2018 on a timely manner, but inadvertently failed to post that report to its public inspection file until the next day after the deadline on February 2, 2018.

WADO(AM), New York, NY (the "Station") believes that it has generally met the requirement in Section 73.1943(c) of the FCC rules to post political orders to the online public inspection file "immediately, absent unusual circumstances." The Station is not aware of any political spot for which it did not post information to the public inspection file. In an abundance of caution, the Station reports the following:

- In May 2021, the Station uploaded information regarding a candidate ad for Eric Adams, 39 days after the contract was finalized.
- In June 2021, the Station uploaded information regarding two candidate ads one for Eric Adams and one for Ray McGuire, one 18 days and the other 7 days after the contract was finalized.
- In October 2021, the Station uploaded information regarding three candidate ads two for Eric Adams and one for Phil Murphy, between 6 to 15 days after the contract was finalized.

Univision notes, however, that it is now subject to a consent decree with the FCC which requires certain remedial practices regarding its stations' political files and reporting of future non-compliance. See Order, DA 21-1536, released December 9, 2021.
