Regarding Facility 189735 WTSN-CD

Reacting to the change in E/I programming in 2019 Antenna TV made a decision to reduce E/I programming to one hour a week. A large number of Antenna TV affiliates are subchannels. It was decided they would instead supplement the main channel's E/I obligation with one hour a week while the main channel would provide two hours a week. The memo, below, was sent September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019. My employment with Three Sisters Broadcasting began in February 2020. Antenna TV sent no other reminder of this change which took place in September 2020 beyond the normal E/I paperwork. The discrepancy wasn't realized until preparing the files. Efforts have been made to ensure the correct amount of E/I programming is aired for 2022.

As you know there are some changes to the Children's Programming requirement.

Antenna TV currently provides 4 hours of E/I programming.

There will be no change on 9/16 on Antenna TV.

Starting on 10/1/19, Antenna TV will have three (3) hours of E/I for the 2019-2020 season.

In September of 2020, Antenna TV will carry one hour of E/I programming.

As a reminder, there is no local inventory during our E/I block.

You will see an amended schedule later this week.
