

## LRS Radio WEHM License Renewal Application Exhibit

During this past license term, LRS Radio, LLC (“LRS”), licensee of radio broadcast station WEHM, due to inadvertent error, did not timely upload to its FCC online public inspection file the following documents:

- (1) Quarterly issues and programs lists beginning with the 4th quarter of 2019; and
- (2) Political advertising orders.

LRS uploaded the missing quarterly issues and programs lists promptly upon discovery of the errors.

LRS has also, promptly upon discovery of the political file errors, begun the process of uploading to its online files political orders from the last two years. LRS is making a good faith effort to ensure that future political advertising documents are timely placed in the online inspection file.

LRS notes that it timely uploaded its 2020-21 EEO Public File Report to the “Additional Documents” section found under the Station Information icon in the station’s FCC-hosted online public inspection file. LRS recently uploaded a duplicate copy of this annual EEO report to the “Additional Documents” section found under the Equal Employment Opportunity Records icon in the station’s online public file.

LRS also notes that its station operations have been severely disrupted by the onset and continuation of the COVID-19 pandemic. This national crisis has worked substantial hardships on the stations in the form of, inter alia, a sharply reduced advertising base and an inability to maintain normal office operations.
