Dear Permittee,

This concerns the above-referenced request for waiver of the Commission's tolling provisions and tolling of the Station's construction permit expiration date (Request). We are unable to process the Request without additional information. Therefore, please provide the following information:

1. A detailed accounting of all steps taken to complete construction since the grant of the construction permit extension including dates for each action and supporting documentation.
2. A detailed accounting of any and all circumstances outside of your control that prevented construction since the grant of the construction permit extension including dates of each circumstance and supporting documentation. Please describe how such circumstance(s) directly impacted construction.
3. A detailed accounting of what construction remains and a timeline plan of how and when you expect to complete construction and begin operations.

Please file the above-outlined information in the form of an amendment to the Request. Failure to submit this information within 30 days of the date of this letter will result in the dismissal of the Request.¹ As an alternative to amending the Request with the requested information, the Permittee may request withdrawal of the Request and submit its construction permit for cancellation.

In addition, the Commission's records are unclear as to the current operational status of the Station. If the Station terminated analog operations prior to July 13, 2021, to comply with the Commission's analog termination deadline, 47 CFR § 74.731(m), then it must submit a request for authority to remain silent.
