Public Inspection File

The Station completed its 2nd quarter 2017 issues/program list in a timely manner, but inadvertently posted the incorrect report to its public inspection file, the correct report was uploaded during the review of the files in preparation for the license renewal.

The Station completed its 3Q quarter 2018 issues/program and 3Q quarter 2018 commercial limits certification in a timely manner, but on the day of the deadline the FCC OPIF database was experiencing technical issues (screenshot below). As a result of the technical issues the upload of both documents occurred after 12AM Central Time.

KWEX-DT, San Antonio, TX (the "Station") believes that it has generally met the requirement in Section 73.1943(c) of the FCC rules to post political orders to the online public inspection file "immediately, absent unusual circumstances." The Station is not aware of any political spot for which it did not post information to the public inspection file. In an abundance of caution, the Station reports the following:

- The Station received an order for local candidate Elizabeth Campos on July 9, 2020 and posted that information to the public file on July 15, 2020.
- The station received advance orders for the House Majority Pac Campaign on September 11, 2020, which were posted September 23, 2020, and October 20, 2020, and on October 6, 2020, which was posted October 19, 2020, before the flight date.
- The Station received an order for state candidate Pete Flores on October 2, 2020 and posted information about that ad on October 13.
- The Station received an order for an issue ad buy for Better Jobs Together on November 2, 2021 and posted information about that ad on November 8.
