FCC Form 303-S Online Public Inspection File

In an abundance of caution, Station notes that its online public inspection file currently contains an up-to-date list of contracts in accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526(e)(5). Station's most recent Biennial Ownership Report (dated November 30, 2021) contained a list of such contracts; however, this list had not been separately uploaded as a standalone document to Station's online public inspection file. Station promptly remedied this issue upon its discovery.

Station was delayed in uploading two quarterly TV issues/programs lists reports, as required by 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526(e)(11)(i), and one certification on records concerning commercial limits, as required by 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526(e)(11)(ii). Station uploaded its quarterly TV issues/programs list and certification on records containing commercial limits for the fourth quarter of 2020 two days late. Station did not receive all information needed to complete the reports from the previous station owner until January 13, 2021, after the filing deadline had passed. Once the Station obtained access to all necessary information, it promptly filed the report in its public inspection file that same day.

Station uploaded its quarterly TV issues/programs report for the first quarter of 2021 nine days late. Due to a miscommunication among Station staff, the staff responsible for uploading the report was not aware at the time that they needed to file a report for the first quarter, as no local programming had aired on the Station during the reporting period. Upon recognizing the error, the Station promptly uploaded the report.

Station takes seriously its obligations under the FCC's rules, including the online public inspection file rule, and it is taking steps to remedy and avoid any recurrence of the issues that caused the late filings disclosed above. Station is undertaking measures to ensure that all required documentation is uploaded to the online public inspection file by deadlines under the FCC rules and that all available documents remain up-to-date. Station has reviewed the filing requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526(e) with outside counsel and has reinforced those requirements with station staff.
