Pending or Resolved Complaints

On February 26, 2016, former KABB(TV) employee April Young filed a charge before the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (“EEOC”) alleging discrimination based on race and sex. EEOC Charge No. 451-2016-01220. On April 19, 2017, the EEOC issued a Dismissal and Right to Sue.

On February 21, 2017, the stations received a charge filed by KABB(TV)/WOAI-TV account executive Ashleigh Manjack before the Texas Workforce Commission Civil Rights Division and EEOC alleging discrimination based on sex, disability, and pregnancy. EEOC Charge No. 451-2017-01059. On August 4, 2017, the EEOC issued a Dismissal and Right to Sue.

On November 2, 2017, Ms. Majack filed a complaint with the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Texas, San Antonio. Case No. 5:17-cv-1116. On May 8, 2018, the parties reached a settlement and signed a release.

On May 4, 2017, former KABB(TV)/WOAI-TV employee Jocelyn Durand filed a complaint before the EEOC alleging discrimination based on sex, sexual harassment, and constructive discharge. EEOC Charge No. 451-2017-01755. On May 16, 2017, the EEOC issued a Dismissal and Right to Sue.

On November 15, 2019, KABB(TV) marketing consultant Andrea Saucedo-Rodriguez filed a complaint before the Texas Workforce Commission Civil Rights Division and the EEOC alleging discrimination based on sex. EEOC Charge No. 451-2020-00581. On September 11, 2020, the EEOC issued a Dismissal and Right to Sue.

On February 1, 2022, WOAI Licensee, LLC received an email from a former WOAI-TV employee, Brian Collister, stating that he filed a charge with the Texas Workforce Commission and EEOC alleging retaliation. WOAI Licensee, LLC has not received any information from the EEOC regarding a complaint as of the date of this Form 396 filing.
