

Amendment

The instant amendment (“Amendment”) is being submitted to update the ownership information reported for Apollo Global Management, Inc. (“AGM”) in the applications¹ seeking consent of the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) to the assignment (“Assignment”) of the Eugene Station Licenses (as defined in Assignee’s Comprehensive Exhibit) from California Oregon Broadcasting, Inc. (“COBI”) to Broadcasting Licenses, Limited Partnership (“Broadcasting Licenses”). Specifically, this Amendment reflects that Board of Directors (the “Board”) of AGM increased from sixteen to seventeen directors, and that Jessica Bibliowicz, a United States citizen, was appointed to the Board as a result of this increase.² The Amendment also reflects minor adjustments in the percentages of voting interests in AGM held by Marc Rowan (6.2% to 6.1%), Scott Kleinman (0.6% to 0.7%), James Zelter (0.6% to 0.7%), and Leon Black (15.01% to 15.0%). Lastly, the Amendment corrects the citizenship of Pauline Richards.³

¹ In addition to the applications being filed to obtain consent to the assignment of the Eugene Station Licenses, a separate application is being submitted to seek authority for the assignment of those wireless telecommunications licenses held by the COBI that are used in connection with the operations of the Eugene Station Licenses.

³ The initial application listed Ms. Richards’ citizenship as U.S. and Canada. Ms. Richards is a citizen of the U.K., Canada, and Bermuda. Ms. Richards’ role as a director of AGM has been approved in prior transactions. See, e.g., LMS File No. 0000165925.
