

KXCD ONLINE PUBLIC INSPECTION FILE EXHIBIT

The Quarterly Issues/Programs lists are now uploaded and complete, however, in completing the renewal application, the staff discovered that some Issues/Programs lists were not timely uploaded by staff to the KXCD OPIF.

The station was purchased in 2018 with a closing of the FCC approved assignment of license on November 21, 2018, accordingly the station is not responsible for issues/programs lists prior to that date. Moreover, the prior licensee took the station off the air at Closing necessitating the new licensee, Lee Family Broadcasting, to obtain FCC approval of silent STA. The Lee Family were able to restore the facilities and operate in early August 2019, and accordingly, there no issues/programs list during the November 2018-August 2019 off-air timeframe.

The Issues/Programs lists for last two quarters of 2018 after on-air operation was restored and 2019-21 quarters were in station's paper public file but not timely uploaded due to a misunderstanding of the staff but are now uploaded.

Management staff at the owners' direction have adopted additional internal procedures to ensure continued compliance with the requirements for the OPIF.
