I am the interim General Manager of the KSLU, Southeastern Louisiana University radio station, 90.9 FM in Hammond, Louisiana.

The building that houses KSLU studios and tower was damaged beyond repair from Hurricane Ida on August 29, 2021. We are in the process of rebuilding the studio and securing a new tower site. The station has to remove our transmitting equipment, studio and tower from the damaged building by May 23, 2022. We will have to go off air on this date and will be off air until the new tower site has been approved by FCC and moving and construction has been completed.

Our goal is for this process to be completed as expeditiously as possible. Southeastern Louisiana University and KSLU are committed to public broadcasting for our community.
