Hello Mark, Kevin, Evan, Barbara, and Shaun,

It was a pleasure to talk to you today. I have submitted the withdrawal for minor mod for KKPM-CD just now. One Ministries, Inc. no longer wishes to pursue moving KKPM-CD greater than 30 miles. I will also submit a letter to withdraw the petition for reconsideration, 0000036125.

Nevertheless, the interference issue to KKPM-CD over the past 25 months persists. Just this week, I had two complaints of interference received from Vernon McCullough, 15877 Willow Glen Rd Brownsville, CA 95919 and Bob Conner 1047 14th St Spc 84 Oroville, Ca 95965.

I am hoping that your team would look kindly on allowing KKPM-CD to increase power to 50 kW to overcome the incoming interference that began April 30, 2020 when stations in the SF Bay Area moved to their post repack channel.
